The facility provides ongoing training and in-services to ensure staff understand laws, regulations, expectations and maintaining a safe environment. ### **QUALIFICATIONS:**

- Be at least 18 years of age
- Be able to follow housekeeping practices, procedures and guidelines established by this facility.
- Ability to work harmoniously with other personnel.
- Ability to minimize waste of supplies, misuse of equipment, etc.
- Possess the ability to seek out new methods and principles and be willing to incorporate them into existing housekeeping practices.
- Be able to follow the written and oral instructions concerning the mixture of cleaning compounds, liquids, cleaning instructions, etc. as directed.
- Must be able to lift, push, pull and move equipment and supplies throughout the work day.
- Ability to work in all areas of the facility.
- Subject to frequent interruptions.
- Subject to reactions from dust, housekeeping and disinfecting solutions, odors, etc.
- May be exposed to infectious diseases, substances, etc.

### **ESSENTIAL DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- Receive and follow cleaning schedule and instructions from your supervisor and/or as outlined in our established housekeeping policies and procedures.

- Duties include cleaning resident's rooms, living/recreational areas, etc.
- Follow all safety precautions as required by state and federal law.
- Perform cleaning/sanitizing procedures in ISOLATION ROOMS/AREAS as instructed and in accordance with established infection control policies and procedures.
- Attend and participate in in-service educational classes, and on-the-job training programs.
- Attend and participate in workshops, seminars, etc., as approved.
- Assure that the facility is maintained in a clean, safe and orderly manner for resident comfort and convenience.
- Ensure that patients rights to fair and equitable treatment, self determination, individuality, privacy, property and civil rights, including the right to wage complaints, are followed.
- Other related duties as may become necessary or as directed by your supervisor and/or administrator.
- Ability to understand and comply with regulations and facility policy in order to ensure the safety of our residents and employees.

**PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS:**

- Sitting, standing, bending, lifting, pushing, pulling and moving intermittently during working hours.
